However, at the maiden level, a win for any amount of purse money will be considered a win and will count against the horses eligibility to compete in a maiden race. It must be noted though, that while the horse may no longer be considered a maiden, if the purse money earned for the maiden win is a net value of \$2,400 or less, the money earned will not count against the eligibility of the horse when competing against non-winners of two or three lifetime condition levels. Net purse money listed on the back of the official Jockey Club registration papers will be used in this determination. No currency conversion will be made.

To qualify for purse supplements:

- Purse supplements are paid out on purse levels.
- Manitoba-bred 2, 3, 4 and 5-year-old horses must have Canadian papers and meet class/purse level criteria.
- Manitoba-bred 2, 3 and 4 year olds entered in claiming races will have a claiming price of 25% higher. This does not include fillies entered in open races where they already receive a 25% advantage.
- Purse supplements are not paid for stake races and MB restricted claiming and MB restricted allowance races and on purses over \$14900.

To qualify for breeder/stallion awards:

- Breeder and stallion awards are paid out on purse levels.
- Horse must be foaled in Manitoba and have Canadian Registration papers
- Horse must be 2, 3, 4 or 5 years old to earn awards in Class 1, 2, 3, finishing 1st; any age to earn awards in Class 4 and 5 finishing 1st, 2nd, 3rd.
- Horse must be bred by a Manitoba breeder. Out of province breeders are eligible for breeder awards if the mare is bred to a Manitoba based stallion registered to the Manitoba Sire Program and foaled in Manitoba.

The CTHS board reviews the Manitoba Incentive Program monthly and adjustments may be made accordingly.

GENERAL INFORMATION

RACE OFFICE HOURS

Entries open at 6:30 a.m. - Close at 9:30 a.m.

FOAL CERTIFICATE DATE

Anytime on or before Thursday, May 6, 2011, horses will have equal dates when papers are turned into the office. They all will receive a run date of 2011/05/06. After this date, the day you hand your papers in is the run date you will receive.

A horse keeps his opening day date until he races or is scratched. No papers will be accepted for horses that have not been tattooed. All non-starters must be approved by the Paddock Judge before they are entered. Coggins papers must accompany registration papers.

ENTRY DATE

All horses which do not get to run but enter, receive an entry date corresponding to the date on which they are entered. An entry date receives preference over a run date of the same day.

SCRATCHES AND NAMING OF RIDERS

No scratch time. Enter to run. At draw time there will be no open horses. A trainer must name at least two riders at time of entry.

LISTS

Any horse put on a list ie. Vet, Starter, Stewards or Paddock Judges, will receive "NO" date when they come off any of these lists.

PURSE DISTRIBUTION

1st - 60% 2nd - 20% 3rd - 10% 4th - 5% 5th - 3% 6th through last - \$60.00

MANITOBA LASIX PROGRAM

The use of Lasix must be declared at time of entry and noted on the entry form.

ELIMINATION OF "COUPLED ENTRY" RULE

Please note that the rule classifying horses as a "coupled entry" has been eliminated. All horses owned or trained by the same person will run as "uncoupled".

CLAIMING

If a horse is claimed and its next start is in a claiming race, it must be for a price at least 25% higher unless 10 days has elapsed since the claim, in which case it can start for any price; the 10 days shall not include the day the horse was claimed.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- ◄ The Race Secretary has the right to refuse any entry that is, in his opinion, incapable of a respectable performance.
- ◄ Wins not recorded on the back of the official Jockey Club registration papers will not be considered for determining eligibility or allowances.
- ◄ With regard to Rule 1 (gg) a recognized track means a track on which a charted line is available from either the Daily Racing Form or True Form.
- ◄ **All races with a net value of \$2,400.** or less to the winners will not be considered for determining eligibility or allowances at Assiniboia Downs. However, at the maiden level, a win for any amount of purse money will be considered a win and will count against the horses eligibility to compete in a maiden race. It must be noted though, that while the horse may no longer be considered a maiden, if the purse money earned for the maiden win is a net value of \$2,400 or less, the money earned will not count against the eligibility of the horse when competing against non-winners of two or three lifetime condition levels. Net purse money listed on the back of the official Jockey Club registration papers will be used in this determination. No currency conversion will be made.
- ◄ No registration papers will be accepted for horses that have not been tattooed.
- ◄ Coggins papers must accompany registration papers. All horses on the grounds (including ponies) must have a negative coggins on file in the race office by April 19, 2011. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- ◄ No Horse will receive a timed, registered workout unless registration papers are in the Race Office.
- ◄ All races not designated as fillies & mares, will be colts & geldings preferred.
- ◄ In all overnight races excluding maiden races, winners will be preferred unless otherwise stated in the condition of the race.
- ◄ Only Thoroughbreds and Quarter Horses of racing age and working pony horses are allowed on the grounds.
- ◄ When entering horses Owners and Trainers are cautioned to check carefully as to the eligibility of horses in their care and allowances claimed in races. Under the universal rules of racing, an owner or trainer is responsible for the weight his horse carries. The Racing Secretary will be glad to give the horsemen any information in respect to their horses that is desired, but the final responsibility rests with the owners and trainers.
- ◄ This race meet is being conducted with the approval of the Manitoba Horse Racing Commission, and the Rules of Racing of the Manitoba Horse Racing Commission apply to the conduct of all races and the Association conducting this meet has been licensed by the Manitoba Horse Racing Commission.
- ◄ The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency (CPMA) has implemented testing for the following veterinary approved anabolic steroids: boldenone, nandrolone, stanozolol and testosterone, as of June 1st, 2009.

Revised September 20, 2008 **PLEASE READ CAREFULLY**

For purpose of Rule 1 (rr) and Rule 31 (17) the prescribed minimum distances and times to be recognized as an official workout are as follows:

Horses entering to run less than 6 furlongs:

- a) A horse which has not started for period of 30 days or more shall not be allowed to enter into a race unless it has one official recorded workout of not less than 3 furlongs.
- b) A horse which has not started for a period of 45 days or more shall not be allowed to enter unless there has been one official recorded workout of not less than 4 furlongs within 30 days of entry.
- c) A horse which has not started for a period of 60 days or more shall not be allowed to enter unless it has two official recorded workouts. One workout shall not be less than 4 furlongs. Workouts must be within 30 days of entry.
- d) A horse which has not started for a period of one year or more shall not be allowed to enter unless it has two official recorded workouts of not less than 4 furlongs. One workout shall be approved by the commission veterinarian and one shall be from the starting gate within 30 days of entry.

Horses entering to run 6 furlongs or longer:

- e) A horse which has not started for a period of 30 days or more shall not be allowed to enter into a race unless it has one official recorded workout of not less than 3 furlongs;
- f) A horse which has not started for a period of 45 days or more shall not be allowed to enter unless there has been one official recorded workout of not less than 4 furlongs within 30 days of entry.
- g) A horse which has not started for a period of 60 days or more shall not be allowed to enter unless it has two official recorded workouts. One shall not be less than 5 furlongs. Both workouts must be within 30 days of entry.
- h) A horse which has not started for a period of one year or more shall not be allowed to enter unless it has three official recorded workouts within 45 days of entry. One shall not be less than 5 furlongs and be approved by the Commission Veterinarian and be within 30 days of entry. One workout must be from the starting gate within the current meeting (if gate workout is outside of 45 days of entry, horse is still required to have three official recorded workouts within 45 days).
- i) Two year olds and first lifetime starters shall not be allowed to enter unless it has two official recorded workouts. Both workouts must be within 30 days of entry. One shall not be less than 4 furlongs.
- j) If entered at a distance of 6 furlongs or longer one workout shall not be less than 5 furlongs.
- k) Horses must have one official recorded workout from starting gate within 60 days of entry.

The minimum time to be recognized as an official workout are as follows:

3 furlongs 40 (dogs up 41) two year olds 40 (dogs up 42)
4 furlongs 53 (dogs up 55) two year olds 54 (dogs up 56)
5 furlongs 1:07 (dogs up 1:08) two year olds 1:07 (dogs up 1:09)
6 furlongs 1:18 (dogs up 1:19&3) two year olds 1:19 (dogs up 1:21)
7 furlongs 1:34
1 mile 1:48

All workouts must be in qualifying times, must be for the full distance and any horse coming of the Vet's list must have a 4 furlong workout approved by the Commission Veterinarian.

Trainers starting horses for the first time at the current meet shall disclose the fact that the horse has been running at unrecognized tracks. Contact with the clockers about workouts can **ONLY** be made through the two-way radios secured to the track rail by the 1 1/8 chute, outside of the maintenance building, and by the 7 Furlong start point. Office and cellular phone calls will not be recognized. Please ensure you confirm your workout with the clockers immediately after or by checking the posted sheets outside of the Race Office.

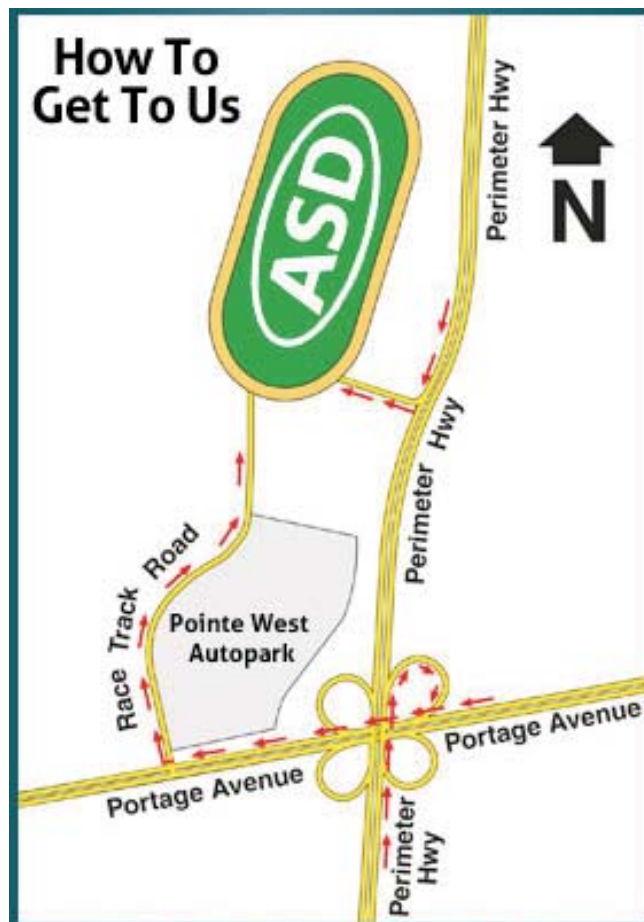
